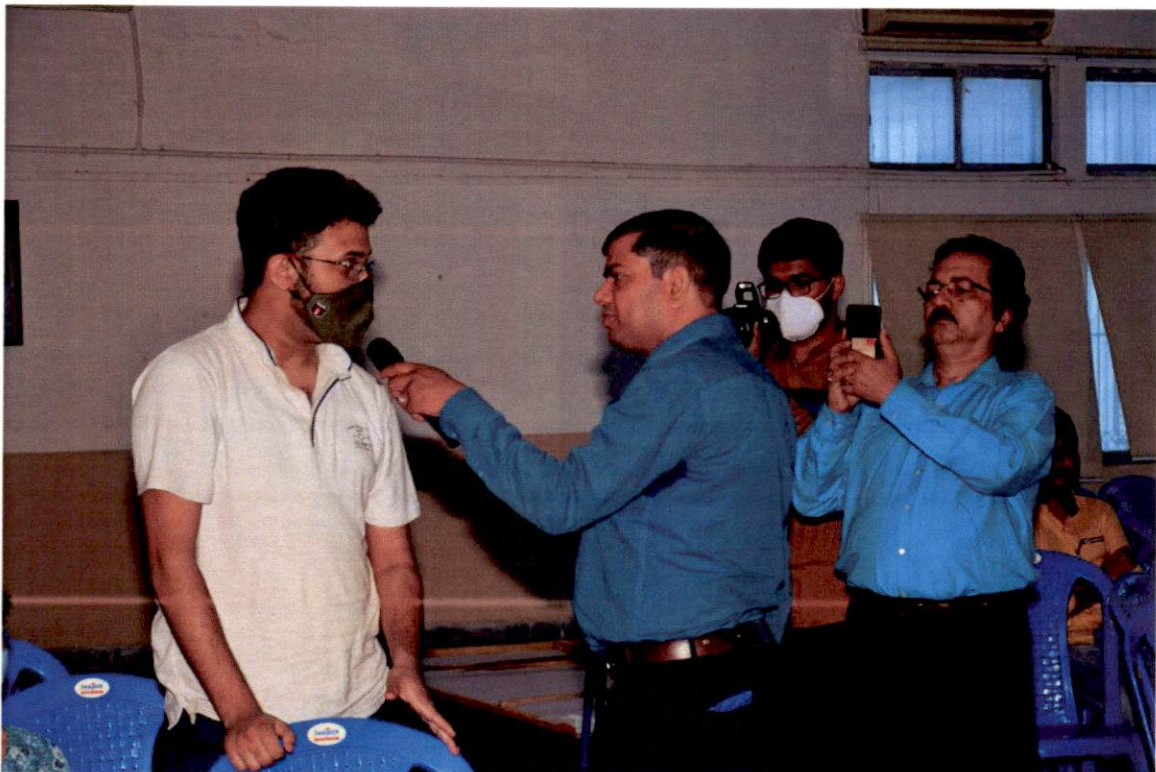

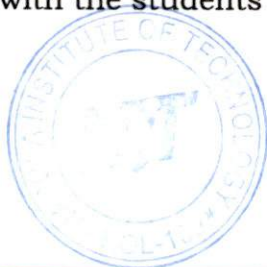



**The session came to an end by the vote of thanks by Dr. Anilesh Dey, member-MHRD IIC Council.**

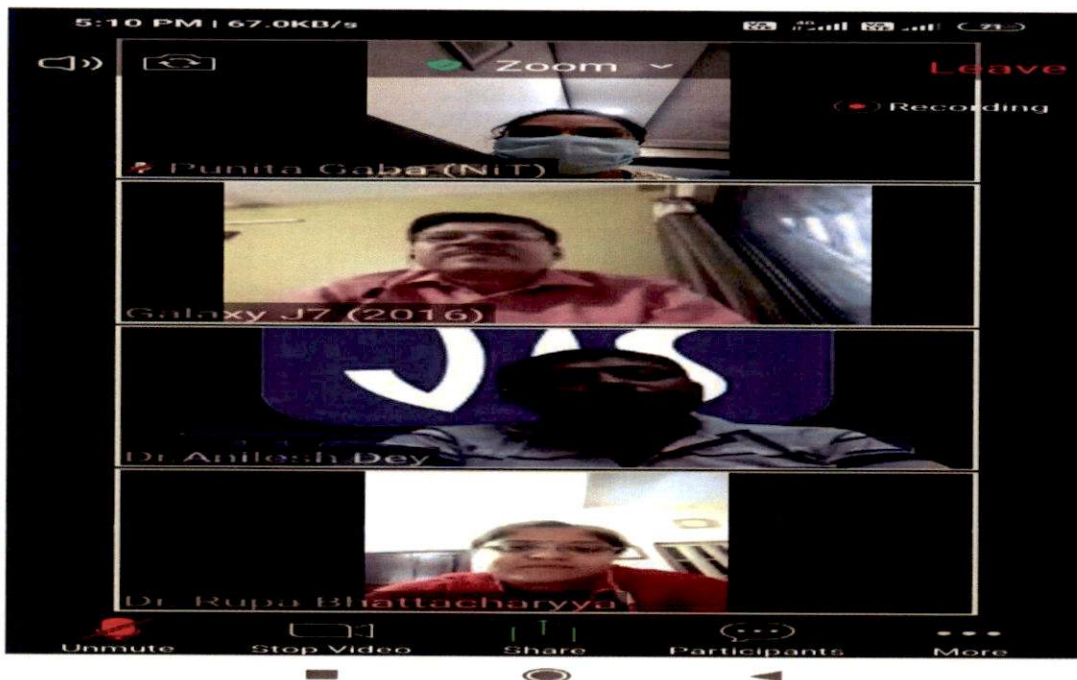

5. On **18th December,2020** a Cultural event was witnessed where students performed songs, recitation, dance etc. which was hosted by Women Cell members.

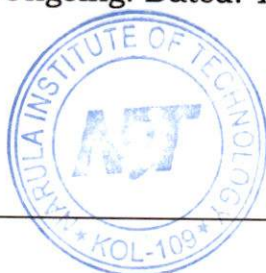

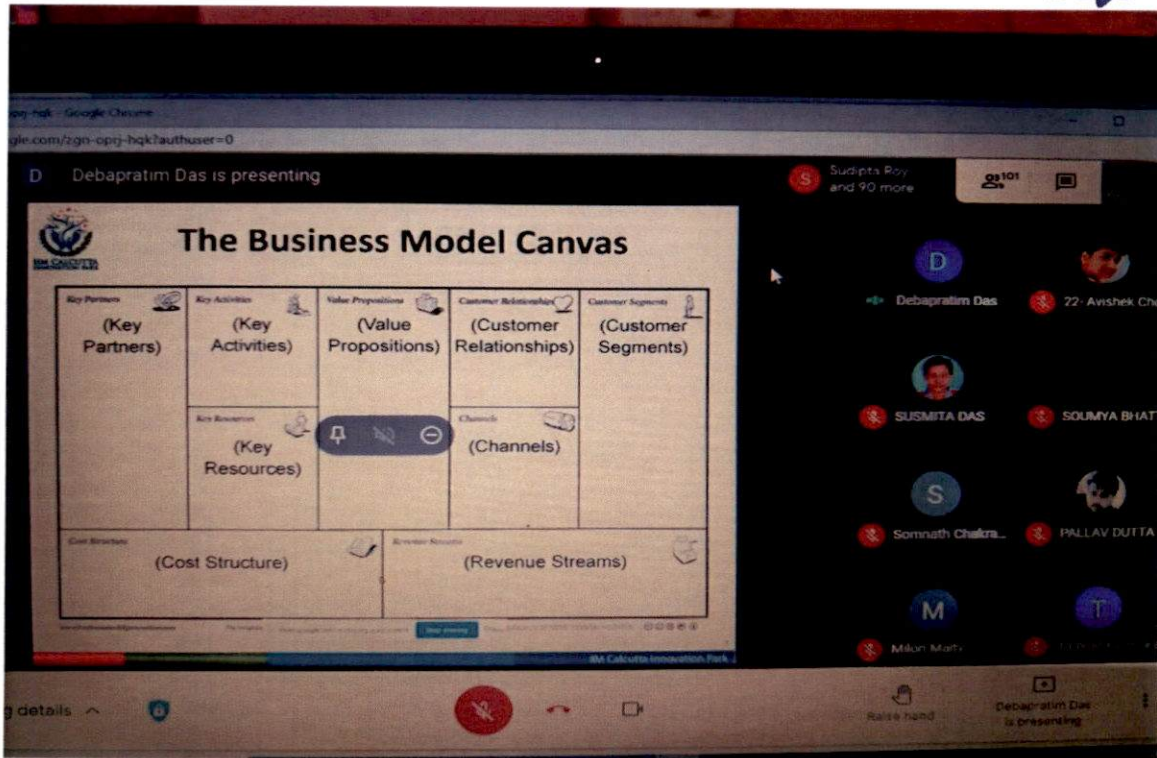

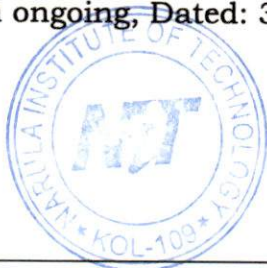
that requires a lot of heavy investing initially cause unless they belong to a family of rich businessmen. The overwhelming students interacted enthusiastically with the speaker.
