

Report on Career Counseling Programs during 2022-2023

The institute's main goal is to train students so they can choose the right path for their career advancement. It is important to highlight the stages of development and learning by enabling children to learn about their options for the future based on their needs, interests, and capabilities. The institute has organized the following programs for career counseling: -

1. Training on Aptitude & Verbal & Non-Verbal Reasoning Test

A course on aptitude, verbal and nonverbal reasoning tests, and online platform campus recruitment drives for several companies has been held. The lessons were designed to improve the students' logical aptitude and reasoning skills, which will enhance their knowledge, promptness, and confidence. The sessions took place once a month, from August through December. 728 were enrolled in the training session overall. Mr. Debanjan Dey, a well-known national aptitude trainer, has been leading the sessions.

2. Mock Interview Sessions

Every year, the Institute hosts online mock interviews to help students become successful and self-assured during recruitment campaigns. From September to December, there was one session per month. About 728 came to the program.

4. Pre placement Talks



Report on Training for Competitive Examinations during 2021-2022

The primary goal of competitive test preparation programs is to persuade students to participate in various competitive exams (GATE, GRE, etc.). It also aids in educating pupils about the various competitive exam formats that are available. This kind of training program prepares a student to meet obstacles in any exam related to higher education. These programs' specifics, as they are organized this year, are listed below.

1. Training class for competitive exam GATE

For the entire semester (August to January), Narula Institute of Technology has arranged training workshops for all final and pre-final year students across all departments to gain the capacity to solve a variety of problems for the GATE (Graduate Aptitude Test for Engineers). Several professors from other departments used to deliver these training sessions virtually. The program was attended by 259 students.
