Agenda 1: Confirmation of Minutes of the Last BoS Meeting

Resolution:

Agenda 2: Approval of Action Taken Report of the Resolutions Taken in the Last BoS Meeting

Resolution:

The action taken report was presented and approved unanimously. Members acknowledged that the resolutions from the previous BoS meeting had been properly implemented.
