❖ Industrial Visit to Dronestech Lab at IIM Calcutta Innovation Park

The Electronics and Communication Engineering Department of Narula Institute of Technology organized an enriching industrial visit to the Dronestech Lab at IIM Calcutta Innovation Park on August 20, 2025. This immersive experience—attended by both students and faculty—offered hands-on exposure to state-of-the-art drone technology. Participants explored diverse aspects of drone systems, including carbon-based structural materials, advanced camera technologies such as the SkyCam2 and 1200 TVL, and critical software platforms like C and MATLAB for image processing. They also gained practical insights into stabilization mechanisms like the Inertial Measurement Unit (IMU).



❖ Industrial Visit to Variable Energy Cyclotron Centre (VECC), Kolkata

On 13th August 2025, forty students of 3rd Year CSE, accompanied by two faculty members, visited the Variable Energy Cyclotron Centre (VECC). The objective of the visit was to provide students with practical exposure to advanced research in nuclear science, accelerator technology, and their applications in computing and data analysis.

The program began with an introduction to VECC's activities, followed by a guided tour of key facilities, including the Cyclotron accelerator, radiation laboratories, and high-performance computing divisions. An interactive session with scientists further enhanced the experience, highlighting the role of nuclear research in medicine, industry, and national development, while also emphasizing the importance of radiation safety protocols.
