'Storytelling helps legacy brands connect with different generations'

Kolkata: A brand's relevancy needs to be channelled through various mediums to connect with different cohorts and ages of society while keeping the core message of the brand intact. Storytelling acts as the bridge that helps brands relate to multi-



ple consumers and segments of society, setting a footprint as generations and trends pass by. This was the message from Anirban Banerjee, chief executive officer of Eveready Industries India Limited, to the students of the Narula Institute of Technology. He was on campus on Dec 11 as part of The Times of India's initiative 'Leaders on Campus', where he delivered a motivational talk on "Changing Storytelling of a Legacy Brand", sharing key insights

ol for explaining the relevancy of the product and the brand, thus being pivotal in building evocative relationships between the consumers and the brand," said Banerjee. Banerjee urged students that storytelling needs to be vibrant and diverse, based on the core appeal of the brand, which leverages its relevance to different generations of society while tapping into their specificities and needs. The emotional connection and the medium of commu-

nication might be different, but the core idea of the brand needs to sustain through the changes in its storytelling over the ages. He said that legacy brands need to balance communication with various generations so they can adapt to newer generations and maintain the emotive relationship with past generations. "The entire trick potentially lies in trying to tell a story in a way that does not alienate your core. It's like saying that you built yourself for decades of consumers who believe in you, and that is what gives you heritage, legacy, and a certain amount of culture around it. You try to narrate it to the next set without alienating it." Banerjee concluded his talk with advice for students to explore their capabilities. Like brands, one needs to remain relevant over the long span of their career. To keep oneself upskilled will be great, and the goal should be to remain relevant from the start to the end, he said.






Campus to Company
