

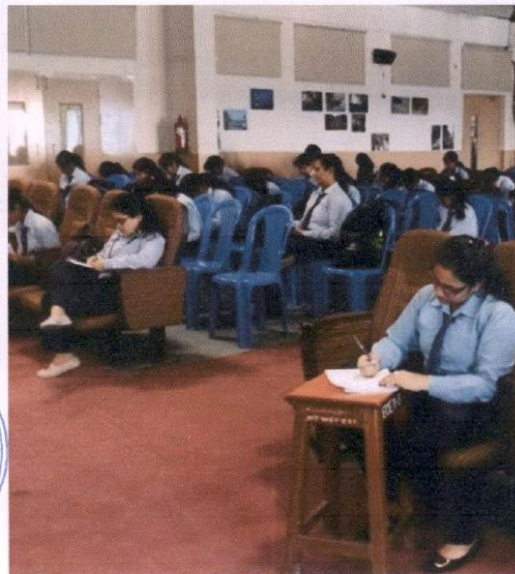
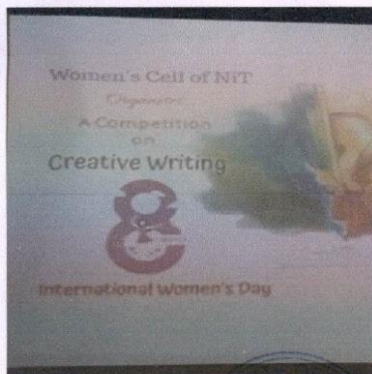


Programmes organised in the Academic year 2018-2019
