Narula institute of technology had organized “Breast cancer Awareness Programme” on 14/05/2020. The speaker of this programme was Dr.Sanjoy Sen, MBBS, MS, MRCS (England).

He delivered the lecture on how lifestyle and good habits are important to fight against cancer. He also told that better awareness about breast cancer and its early detection can greatly reduce the need for more advanced forms of treatment.

The programme was conducted through online and total 72 girls and 25 faculty members participated in the programme.

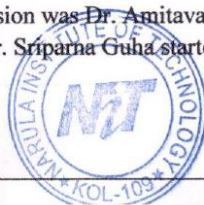


One day seminar on Psychological Issues in a Pandemic Situation organised by Women Cell, NiT on 20th June, 2020

Guest Speaker for the 1st session was Dr. Amitava Sur,MD,DM Endocrinology. Convener of Women Cell, Dr. Sriparna Guha started the Session with a welcome address.



Dr. Sur emphasised on the important issues like health of the elderly people, importance of vaccination and various causes of diabetes and talked about “Management of Diabetes in a Pandemic Situation” In this session, a total of five papers were presented by the students.

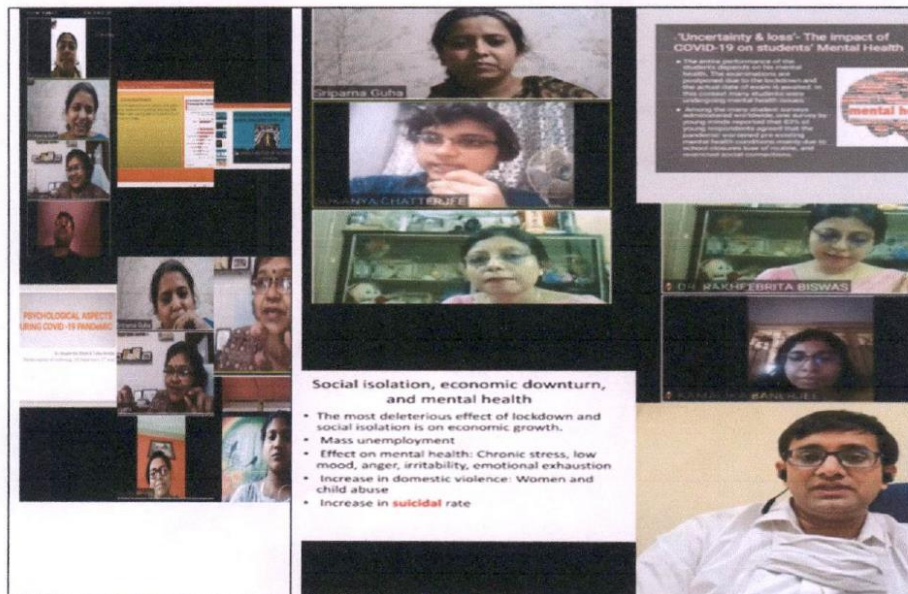

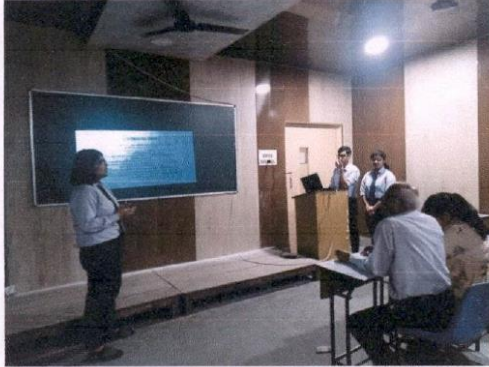

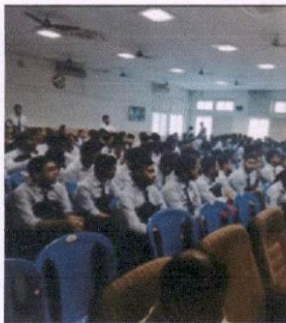



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Programme on "Women & Entrepreneurship"
