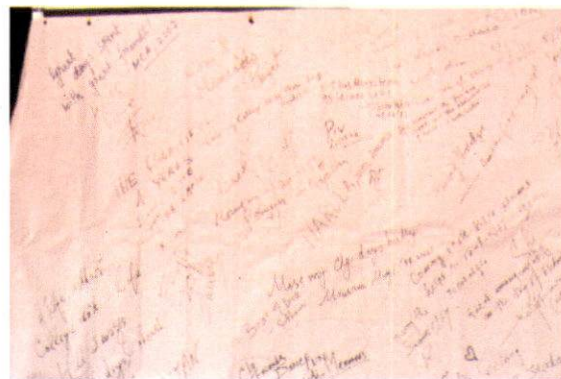

The Meet ended with a sweet hope of Meeting again with Alumni next year. NiT looks forward for a greater partnership with the Alumni in the days to come.

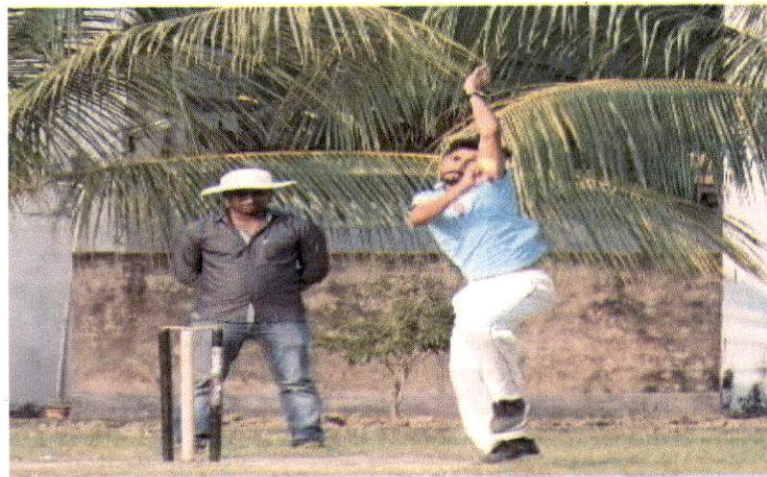

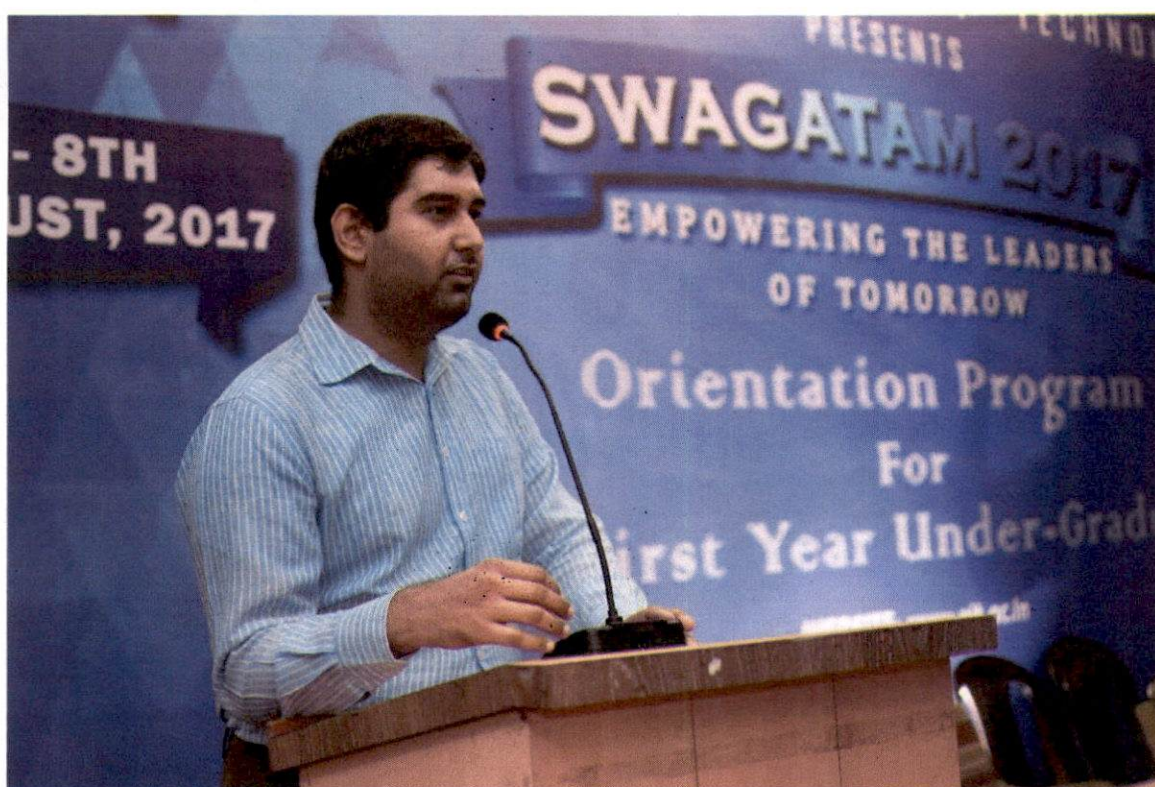

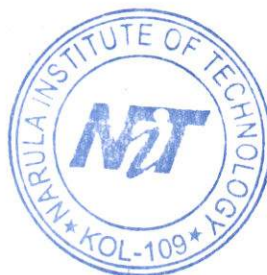
8th August, 2017

Professional Training Program on “Basic Electronics, Embedded Systems, PLC, SCADA & PCB Design”

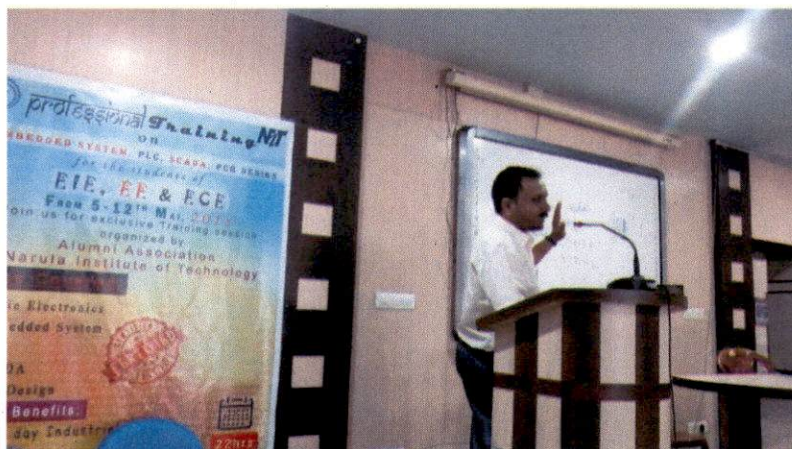

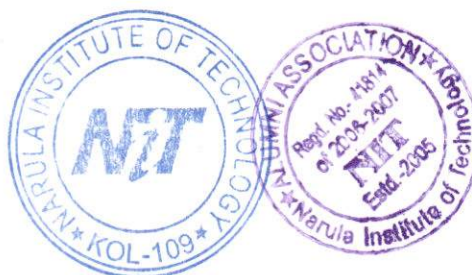
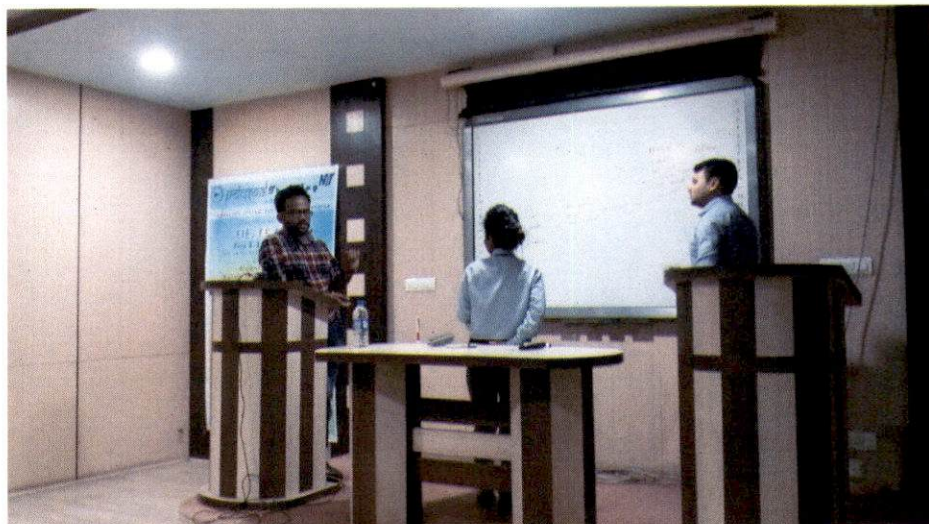


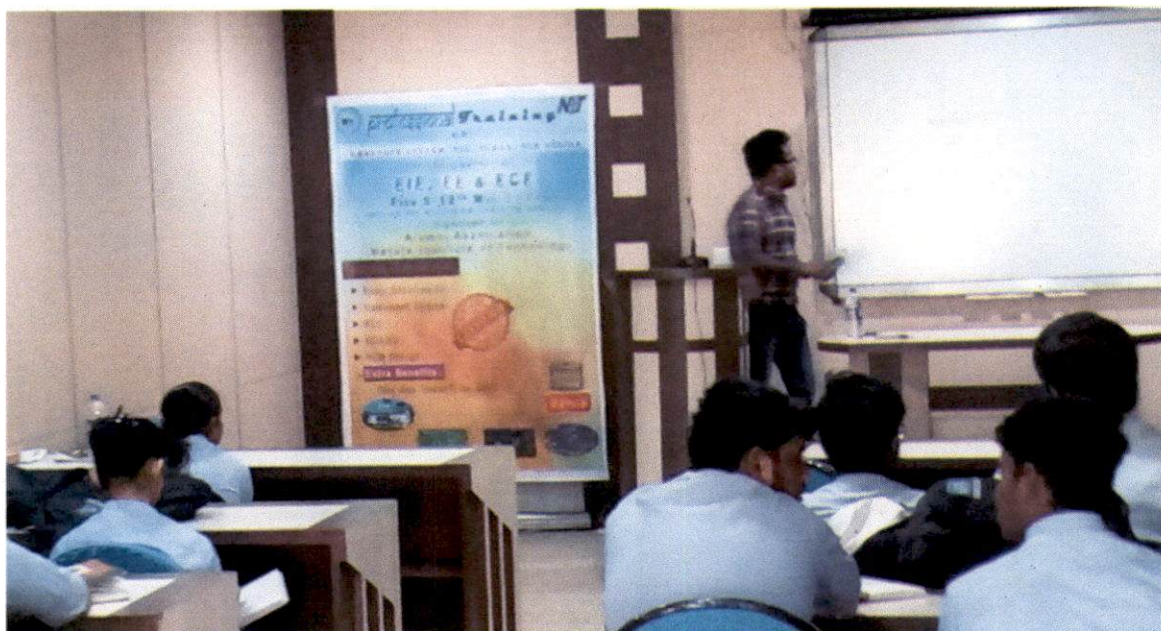
Day 2: 09.05.2018

programming. The session was very much interactive and informative also.



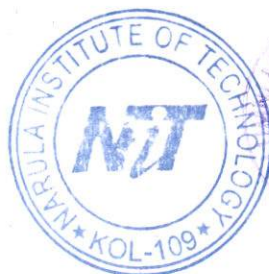


Day 3: 10.05.2018

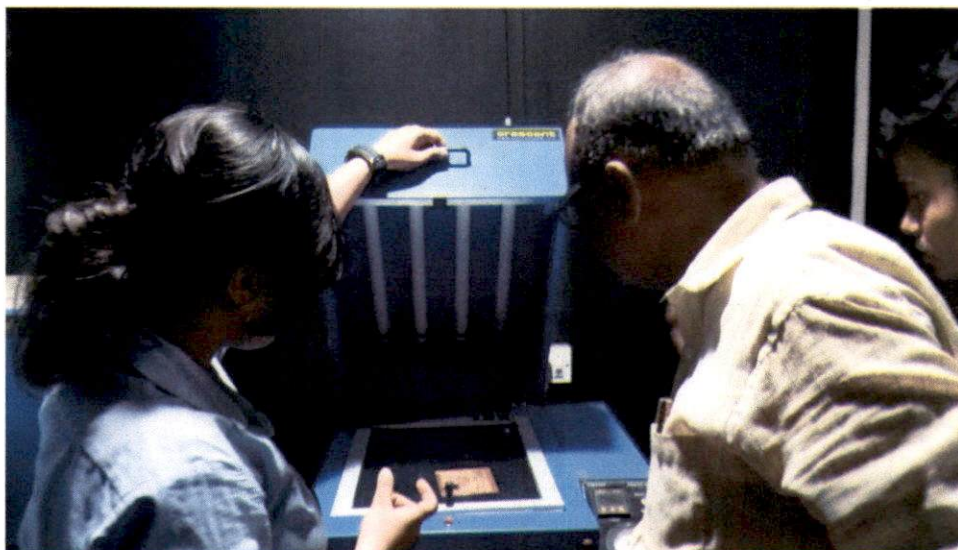


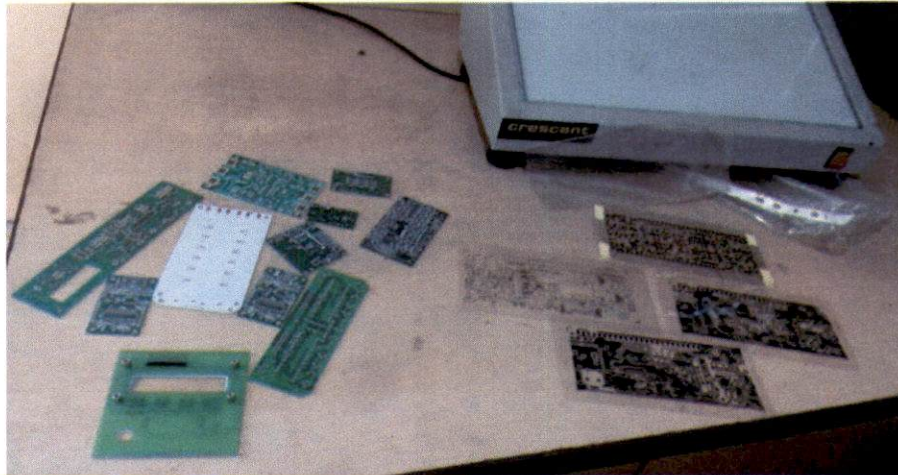
Day 4: 11.05.2018

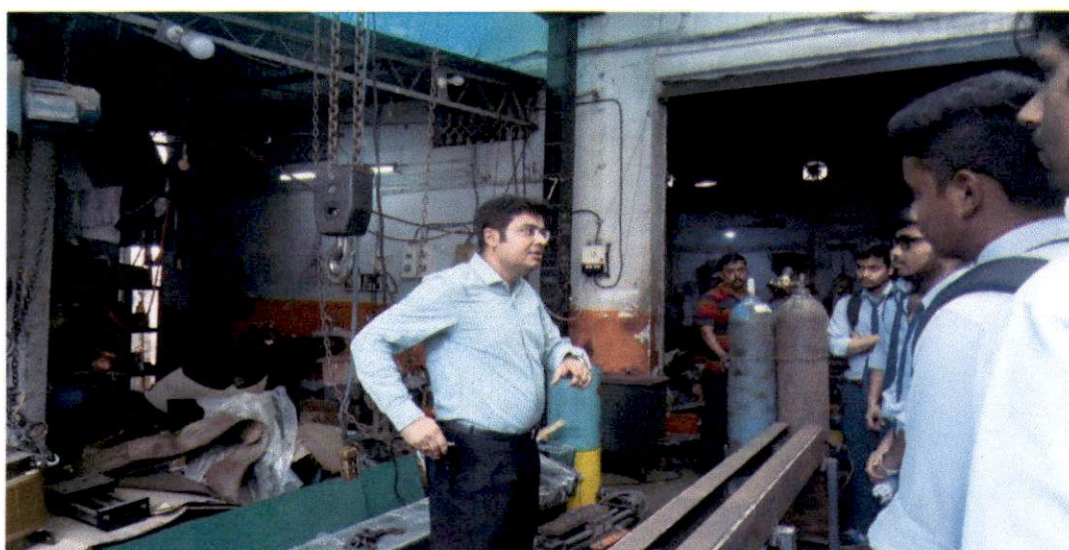
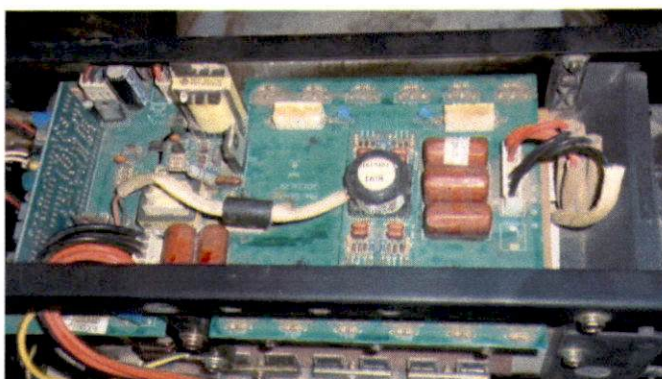


Report on Industrial visit
