



Around 100 number of students including faculty Members and Technical Staffs participated in the event. The session was highly interactive with the speaker and participants.






Report on Alumni Meet-EIE Department Narula Institute of Technology 12th May 2020

The webinar was presided over by Mr. Sourav Majumdar, Alumni, Electronics and Communication Engineering, Narula Institute of Technology. He is a senior person in the field of project and program management. He currently works as senior project manager at Wipro Technologies. He has travelled globally and dealt with various international clients. He also has certification in Project Management, Amazon Web Services (AWS) cloud, Google cloud and Azure cloud. More than 30 students along with faculty members actively participated in the session through Zoom platform.

The webinar has started with the inaugural welcome speech of Mr. Sourav Majumdar. 






The session was very inspiring and motivating for students and everything was explained in a proper and beautiful manner that cultivates the minds of people with lots of knowledge and profound concepts.








Webinar on "Career after engineering" by Divyendu Jha, Alumni ECE Narula Institute of Technology


